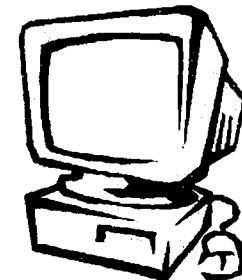
Materials Not accepted:

No - Explosives and Radioactive materials.

No - Latex Paint - it is not a hazard dried.

Use kitty litter to absorb liquid, before placing in trash.

No - Waste Oil - as it can be recycled at the Fabius Recycling Program on Saturdays at the landfill and by several service stations and auto parts stores.

Collected material will be handled by IT Scrap. Program open to St. Joseph County residents and small businesses.
